Administrative Monthly Report Monday January 11, 2021

Easement Status:

NRCS has not announced the FY21 application deadline or provided the final application matrix as of January 8. ABPP is still reviewing our application.

Projects in process:

Working with Berkeley FPB on a proposal for an easement monitoring contractor for both counties. Concept discussed with Potomac Conservancy on 10/16. We are preparing a proposal for Board review.

Easement review: Twelve easements so far contain errors, some more complicated to resolve than others. Grant Smith has reviewed the proposals for correction or amendment on co-held easements.

Procedures manual: As part of the succession planning, this is an on-going project to document the various procedures for running the Farmland Protection Program.

Annual Report: On Jan 7 I sent the Board a draft and cover letter for comment

Forestry Policy Review – Easement Committee will take this up in January.

Administrative:

Bookkeeping: Jane Jones showed Catharine Johnson the Quick Books account on Jan 8.

Donation: We received \$10,400 in December, \$200 in January. \$28,422 total for 2020.

Record-keeping: We have been exhuming financial records to find easement costs for the audit so that easements can be capitalized. Also to have accessible the complete record of costs for each easement.

Financial: Russ Quinn confirmed he will help with planning. The Board needs to consider financial plan to reach its goal of 20,000 acres by 2030, the need to budget for a stewardship endowment and easement insurance (Terrafirma), and a stewardship contractor to conduct annual monitoring.
