## Administrative Monthly Report .... Monday March 8, 2021

### **Easement Progress:**

NRCS: Property HFD02 (Moler) submitted to NRCS for funding.

Property SD04 (Printz): ABPP Award (\$225,030.00) for Aspen Pool announced 3/5/2021.

<u>Funded Properties:</u> Property KD01 (Local funding only): Survey completed, showing 306.674 total acres. This means an additional 3.834 acres in the easement. Landowner requested price adjustment. I participated in the Baseline field work on March 7. On March 8 I met with Jennie Brockman in P&Z to discuss plat language requirements.

Property MD01 - The surveyor started work on the survey. The Baseline has been ordered. Phase 1 field work completed (NRCS)

Property SD01 – The survey is done. The Baseline has been ordered. Phase 1 field work completed (NRCS)

<u>Closed Properties:</u> Mrs. Betty Stehr died December 29. The family requested a meeting to discuss the easement terms & etc. I will meet with them in the next week.

Spring Monitoring: Spring monitoring schedule attached in Board packet

<u>Administration:</u> Audit process required several days of collecting and sending documents to Perry & Associates. Additional documentation required because federal funds exceed \$500,000. (\$973,247 in FY20)

EAC Archeology, Cultural Resources Consultant in MD sent proposal for \$5,896 for Printz property baseline and deed.

#### <u>Administrative:</u>

### Projects in process:

Annual Report: The Report has been mailed to 840 names.

Easement review: On March 4 Easement Committee reviewed list of easements that need correction and requested that I propose an implementation plan. Will need to coordinate with LTEP.

Procedures manual: As part of the succession planning, this is an on-going project to document the various procedures for running the Farmland Protection Program.

Working with Berkeley FPB on a proposal for an easement monitoring contractor for both counties. Concept discussed with Potomac Conservancy on 10/16. No progress yet on proposal.

Bookkeeping: Krista Hoffman is the new bookkeeper for JCDA. Jane Jones has been helping orient her to the job, and our bookkeeping needs.

Donations: \$317.38 + \$1,675 = \$1992.38

Other: I have been invited to present to the JCDA Board about the Farmland Protection Program on April 20. I am mailing the annual report to the Board members in advance.

### <u>Financial</u>: <u>Items to be addressed</u>:

Long-range financial plan for the Board goal of 20,000 acres protected by 2030.

Budget for a stewardship endowment and easement insurance (Terrafirma),

Budget for a stewardship contractor to conduct annual monitoring.
